



# Interstate Medical Licensure Compact

The Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Commission is pleased to announce that today, May 13, 2022, Governor Ned Lamont signed into law Connecticut Substitute SB 2 which was passed by the Connecticut General Assembly on May 3, 2022.

Connecticut is the 38<sup>th</sup> member jurisdiction to join the Compact.

The Compact now has 36 states, the District of Columbia and the Territory of Guam as member jurisdictions. There is currently legislation pending in 5 states – Massachusetts, Missouri, North Carolina, Rhode Island, and Virginia.
