

*** FIRST AND FINAL NOTICE ***
The license renewal period will begin on or after April 17, 2023.

Greetings Nevada Licensee:

Your Nevada license is due to expire. If you wish to maintain your license, you must renew before 5:00 P.M. PDT, June 30, 2023. There is no grace period. All licensees should now renew online.

To renew:

Step 1. Go to: <https://medboard.nv.gov/> and click on “RENEW YOUR LICENSE.” This will take you to the Board’s licensee “Service Portal.”

Step 2. Login to the Service Portal using your email address on file with the Board and your Service Portal password. If you have not used the Service Portal before, please click “Activate now,” to receive a temporary password to activate your account.

Step 3. When you have completed your renewal application on the Board’s website, click the link at the end of the application to go to the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact (IMLC) website: <https://imlcc.org/renew>. Pay your renewal fees (\$825.00) and complete the IMLC attestations.

Your license renewal will not be complete until you have completed all three steps.

All licensees should be prepared to attest to completion of their required continuing medical education (CME) on their renewal applications. Further information regarding [CME requirements](#) is available on the Board’s website. Please retain proof of your CME.

ALL MEDICAL DOCTORS:

Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 630.30665, all medical doctors are required to report to the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners, prior to licensure renewal, all in-office surgeries or procedures that involved the use of conscious sedation, deep sedation or general anesthesia, between January 1, 2021, and December 31, 2022. Negative reporting is no longer required. You will be required to attest on your renewal application that you are in compliance with the reporting requirements of NRS 630.30665.
