



Interstate Medical Licensure Compact

The Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Commission is pleased to announce that two (2) additional states have recently joined.

On June 22, 2023, Governor Josh Green, MD, signed into law Hawaii Senate Bill SB674 making Hawaii the 40th member jurisdiction.

On July 6, 2023, Governor Michael Parson, signed into law Missouri Senate Bill SB70 making Missouri the 41st member jurisdiction.

Since operations began in April of 2017, there have been over 69,000 licenses issued through the IMLCC's process helping over 14,000 physicians.

The Compact now has 39 states, the District of Columbia and the Territory of Guam as members. There is currently legislation pending in 3 states – Massachusetts, New York, and North Carolina.
