The Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Commission is pleased to announce that Florida has recently joined.

On March 21, 2024, Governor Ron DeSantis, signed into law Florida SB7016 making Florida the 42nd member jurisdiction.

Since operations began in April of 2017, there have been over <u>93,000 licenses</u> issued through the IMLCC's process helping over 20,000 physicians.

The Compact now has 40 states, the District of Columbia and the Territory of Guam as members. There is currently legislation pending in 3 states – Massachusetts, New York, and North Carolina.
